Hike difficulty level: Moderate

Trail conditions: Some mud and rocks in trail, relatively flat, steep area near Lockatong Creek.

Trails are slightly rustic, as they are in the process of being developed

Wear sturdy shoes. Plan to bring water. Insect repellent might be needed. No restroom facilities

Rain date: October 17, 2009.
