**AMENDMENT TO THE
HUNTERDON COUNTY DISTRICT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN**

A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, December 6, 2011 at 5:30 p.m., in the Freeholders' Meeting Room, 2nd Floor, Main Street County Administration Complex, 71 Main Street, Flemington, New Jersey for the purpose of considering Amendment No. ~~20~~ to the Hunterdon County District Solid Waste Management Plan. The public hearing is being held in accordance with N.J.S.A. 13:1E-23 (c) & (e).

The purpose of the public hearing is to afford the citizens of Hunterdon County and any persons interested in; or who would be effected by; or who are in favor of; or are opposed to the adoption of the proposed Amendment, the opportunity to provide the Freeholders with oral or written comments, suggestions, objection or evidence in respect to the Plan Amendment.

A copy of the Plan Amendment, the recommendation of the Solid Waste Advisory Council, original application and supporting documentation is available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the: 1) Office of the Clerk of the Board of Chosen Freeholders, Main Street County Complex, Building #1, 71 Main Street, Flemington, New Jersey 08822; 2) Office of the District Solid Waste Coordinator, Route 12 County Complex, 314 State Route 12, Building #1, Flemington, New Jersey 08822; 3) branches of the Hunterdon County Library, the main branch at 314 State Route 12, Building #3 of the Route 12 County Complex, Flemington, New Jersey; the North Branch at 65 Halstead Street, Clinton, New Jersey; and the South Branch at 1108-A Old York Road, Ringoes, New Jersey. Under the authority of N.J.S.A. 13:1E-23 (d), a copy of the proposed Plan Amendment can also be inspected in the Office of the Municipal Clerk of every municipality in the County of Hunterdon.

The Solid Waste Management Plan Amendment deals with three topics:

- 1) Inclusion of a proposed recycling facility to be located at 5 & 6 Frontage Road (Block 2; Lots 15 and 15.01) in Union Township, Hunterdon County in the Hunterdon County District Solid Waste Management Plan. The owner of the proposed facility is GreenCycle of Hunterdon, LLC.
- 2) Inclusion of a proposed recycling facility to be located at 5 Foster Lane (Block 27; Lot 32.02) in Raritan Township, Hunterdon County in the Hunterdon County District Solid Waste Management Plan. The owner of the proposed facility is Flemington Concrete Products, LLC.
- 3) Designating the Hunterdon County Board of Chosen Freeholders as the having the sole responsibility for the implementation of the Hunterdon County District Solid Waste Management Plan.

AMENDMENT #19 OF THE HUNTERDON COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

1. INCLUDING A PROPOSED SOLID WASTE FACILITY OPERATED BY GREENCYCLE OF HUNTERDON, LLC
2. INCLUDING A PROPOSED SOLID WASTE FACILITY OPERATED BY FLEMINGTON CONCRETE PRODUCTS, LLC
3. DESIGNATING THE HUNTERDON COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS AS HAVING THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE HUNTERDON COUNTY DISTRICT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN.

1. The Amendment includes a proposed solid waste facility in the Hunterdon County Solid Waste Management Plan. The proposed facility is located at 5 & 6 Frontage Road (Block 22: Lots 15 & 15.01) in Union Township, Hunterdon County. Upon issuance of a solid waste facility permit by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection the facility will be developed and operated by GreenCycle LLC (the applicant).

In accordance with the Hunterdon County Solid Waste Management Plan Procedures for Inclusion of Solid Waste Facilities submission the applicant provided the following information:

The products that would be accepted at the facility and the maximum daily and annual tonnages that would be accepted for each material:

Unpainted wood products:	40 tons per day/8,000 tons annually
Concrete products:	80 tons per day/16,000 tons annually
Brick and block:	40 tons per day/8,000 tons annually
Asphalt:	50 tons per day/10,000 tons annually

The hours of operation of the proposed facility:

Monday through Friday: 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Saturday 7:00 a.m. to noon

The primary traffic routes to and from the proposed facility:

Trucks would access the proposed facility from Interstate 78. Eastbound trucks would get off of Interstate 78 at Exit 12 and proceed on Frontage Road East to the facility. Westbound trucks would get off of Interstate 78 at Exit 13 and proceed on State Route 173 West, turning left at the intersection with Ruppel Road West and directly to the facility.

All traffic accessing the facility would be prohibited from Ruppel Road east of the intersection with State Route 173, State Route 173 west of the intersection with Ruppel Road, Frontage Road west of the intersection with Exit 12 of Interstate 78 and Highland Ridge Road.

The average number of trucks loads to the proposed facility at 40 roundtrips per day. The maximum number of trips was not provided by the applicant.

2. The Amendment includes a proposed solid waste facility in the Hunterdon County Solid Waste Management Plan. The proposed facility is located at 5 Foster Lane (Block 27: Lots 30.02) in Raritan Township, Hunterdon County. Upon issuance of a solid waste facility permit by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection the facility will be developed and operated by Flemington Concrete Products, LLC (the applicant).

In accordance with the Hunterdon County Solid Waste Management Plan Procedures for Inclusion of Solid Waste Facilities submission the applicant provided the following information:

The products that would be accepted at the proposed facility and the maximum daily and annual tonnages that would be accepted for each material:

Concrete/brick/block:	500 tons per day/3,000 tons per week maximum/ 156,000 tons annually
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Asphalt:	None
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The hours of operation of the proposed facility:

Monday through Friday: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Saturday: 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The primary traffic routes to and from the proposed facility:

For vehicles making deliveries to the proposed site: State Route 202 South to Colony Road, taking a right onto Royal Road, a right onto Pennsylvania Avenue, left onto Foster Lane, or,

State Route 202 South to Case Boulevard, left onto Pennsylvania Avenue, right onto Foster Lane.

For vehicles exiting the proposed site: Left onto Pennsylvania Avenue, right onto Case Boulevard, intersecting with State Route 202, or,

Right onto Pennsylvania Avenue, left onto Royal Road, left on Colony Road intersecting with State Route 202.

The number of round trip truck trips to the proposed facility is estimated to be 20 per day. The maximum number of trips was not provided by the applicant.

3. The Hunterdon County Board of Chosen Freeholders is designated as having the sole responsibility for the implementation of the Hunterdon County District Solid Waste Management Plan.
