

ORDINANCE NO. 20 - 21 - 2019

NO STOPPING OR STANDING OF VEHICLES AT ANY TIME ALONG KINGWOOD ROAD (COUNTY ROAD 519) EXCEPT FOR OFFICIAL POSTAL SERVICE VEHICLES, CONTRACTOR VEHICLES ENGAGED IN CONSTRUCTION, REPAIRS OR MAINTENANCE OF BUILDING, TREES, OR VEGETATION ON THE ADJOINING PROPERTY, OR GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES ENGAGED ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS IN FRONT OF THE BAPTISTOWN POST OFFICE IN KINGWOOD TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Township of Kingwood received several complaints regarding hazardous driving conditions exiting Gombosi Lane onto Route 519 in Baptistown, NJ; and

WHEREAS, it was determined the hazardous conditions are due to vehicles parked in front of the Baptistown Post Office along the front of the building along Route 519 in Baptistown, NJ; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Township of Kingwood has requested signs be put up in front of the Baptistown Post Office stating “No Stopping or Standing”; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Kingwood has contacted the County requesting the Department of Public Works regarding the signs to be put up in front of the Baptistown Post Office as a request of the Kingwood Township Governing Body; and

WHEREAS, the Post Master for the Baptistown NJ Post Office, and the Owner of the property confirmed they have no objections to the “No Stopping or Standing” signs for the front of the Post Office along Route 519 in Baptistown NJ; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer recommends the installation of two (2) R7-1 signs in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) including striping delineating the no stopping or standing area to better define its limits.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Committee of the Township of Kingwood, County of Hunterdon, that no person shall stop or stand a vehicle at any time on Kingwood Road (County Route 519) in the Township of Kingwood, as described, except for Official Postal Service vehicles, contractor vehicles engaged in construction, repairs or maintenance of buildings, trees, or vegetation on the adjoining property, or government and public utility vehicles engaged on official business.

BE IT RESOLVED that the effectiveness of this Ordinance is contingent on signs being erected as required by law and approval from the Hunterdon County Board of Chosen Freeholders.

NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced on first reading at a regular meeting of the Kingwood Township Committee of the Township of Kingwood, County of Hunterdon held on the 1st day of August 2019. The Ordinance was then ordered to be published accordance with the law. The said Ordinance will be considered for final reading and adoption at a regular meeting of the Township Committee to be held on the 5th day of September, 2019 at 7:00p.m. or as soon thereafter as the Township Committee may hear this Ordinance at the Municipal Building located at 599 Oak Grove Road, Frenchtown, New Jersey, at which time all persons interested may appear for or against the passage of this Ordinance.
