

ORDINANCE NO. BOH-01- 2017

Please take notice that the following Ordinance was adopted on first reading by the Board of Health of the Township of Kingwood, County of Hunterdon, State of new Jersey, at a meeting held on the 16th day of August 2017. The Ordinance was then ordered to be published according to law. Notice is hereby given that the said Ordinance will be considered for final passage after a public hearing to be held on the 18th day of October, 2017, at a meeting beginning at 7:30 P.M. at the Municipal Building located on the corner of County Road 519 and Oak Grove Road, Kingwood Township, New Jersey, at which time all interested parties will be heard.

ORDINANCE AMENDING PART III “BOARD OF HEALTH LEGISLATION,” OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KINGWOOD, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AMEND CHAPTER 153 “SEWERAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS; NONPUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS AND WELLS,” SECTION 23 “WELL CONSTRUCTION PERMIT” AND SECTION 30 “WAIVER CRITERIA”

WHEREAS, the Board of Health wishes to amend Section 153-23D of the Ordinance to require an entire copy of a well construction permit be submitted in electronic pdf form; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health wishes to amend Section 153-30 of the Ordinance to create two new exemptions for the Three-Part Pump Test; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Kingwood, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1:

Section 153-23D shall be amended as follows:

One copy of the ~~plat~~ entire application in an electronic pdf format is required to be submitted at the time of the application.

Section 2:

Section 153-30 shall be amended to include the following paragraphs:

- B. **Well Yield Diminishment:** Current Well yields, verified by a licensed well driller or consultant, less than the minimum yields as set forth in the table below:

Minimum Yield Requirements for Wells

Well Yield from Constant Rate Test	Residential Water Use
2 to 3 gpm	up to 4 bedrooms
1.5 to 2 gpm	up to 3 bedrooms
1 to 1.5 gpm	up to 2 bedrooms

C. Water Quality Problems:

- i. Presence of total coliform or e-coli bacteria after the chlorination of the well
- ii. Turbidity, sediment or odor issues
- iii. Other drinking water constituents exceeding primary and secondary contaminant standards for drinking water.

Section 3:

If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are repealed but only to the extent of such inconsistency. All other parts of the Code of the Township of Kingwood not inconsistent herewith are ratified and confirmed.

Section 5:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication according to law.
